## **RE: Registered Death Certificate**

One of the important issues we generally attend to whilst assisting you at this time is to apply on your behalf for a formal Death Certificate from Births, Deaths & Marriages.

This document is often needed in relation to various legal and estate issues that you may need to attend to at this time.

After the funeral, the information required to register your loved one's death will be sent to the Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages where it will be matched with the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death and the death registration will be finalised. The Registered Death Certificate will be posted by the Registry to the nominated family representative.

This process may take up to six weeks from the date of the funeral. If you have not received the Registered Death Certificate by six weeks after the funeral, please contact us on 1800 260 444 and we will follow this up on your behalf. Please note that this process may take longer if the coroner is involved.

In addition to legal and estate issues, there are often many other people and organisations you may need to contact. We hope the checklist on the reverse side of this letter is of assistance in this regard.
